

Spring Term Curriculum Letter

Welcome back! I hope everyone had a wonderful Christmas break.

This term, in Geography, we will be studying Earthquakes and Volcanoes. We will be learning about where in the world these events happen and why they happen linking this to our Science work.

English will be based on traditional tales and we will be studying the book Little Evie in the Wild Wood, we will also be writing our own shape poems. We will be continuing with daily grammar lessons and to learn spellings weekly. In Maths we will be learning formal methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The children will also be problem solving to apply their skills.

Maths and English homework will still be set on alternate weeks. There will also be a focus on learning times tables and the associated division facts this term. The children will be given a times table to learn and I will test them on Fridays. The children are also expected to read to an adult for at least 15 minutes a night. Please ensure that you listen to your child read aloud even if they are in Year 5 or 6! It is important to check their fluency and understanding.

PE this term will be dance and hockey, which will take place on a Monday and a Friday, kit should be in school all week.
