Dear Parents

Welcome back, I hope you have all had a good summer break. It has been a strange and unsettling time over the past six months but I hope this term will seem more 'normal' for children and parents. There are still many of the procedures in place from the summer term but most of you will be familiar with these now.

During the Autumn Term the children in Hare Class will be learning through a topic called Art Attack. Please have a look at the termly topic outline on the back of this sheet.

The first half term focus will be on History skills such as sequencing events in chronological order, using art and paintings through History. This will be supported by our English, Art and Music topics.

The second half term will focus on Geography skills and we will be studying climate and biomes around the world.

PE Kit - PE will be on Tuesdays and Fridays so please ensure the correct kit is in on these days. Also please ensure all kit is labelled with the name of your child.

Homework - Children will be expected to read for approximately 20-30 minutes a day which will be recorded in a reading journal. There will be also be weekly spellings and times tables to learn; however the children will also have time in class to work on these. There will also be other English, Maths or topic homework as and when required.
