

English

Out English this term will be focussed on supporting our History topic. The children will learn to write a range of non-fiction texts such as reports, biographies, newspaper reports and instructions. We will also continue with guided reading, phonics, spelling and grammar each week.

Maths

This term we will be covering:
Accurate use of language when making, identifying, describing, comparing and sorting shapes.
Solving one-step and two-step problems
Grid and short multiplication
Division methods
Tell the time from an analogue clock, including roman numerals, 12 hour and 24 hour

Science

In Science the children will be learning about the classification of plants and animals using the binomial system of classification. They will also use and make keys to identify plants and animals. They will also be learning about the human skeleton and muscles.

Art

The children will be making jewellery inspired by the ancient Egyptians. They will design a piece of jewellery, make a mould and cast it in pewter!

The children will be learning how to use the internet to research safely and what to do if inappropriate content pops up. They will also be using the computers to make information leaflets linked to our topic.

History

The children will be studying the Ancient Egyptians. They will learn about the River Nile, Pharaohs, mummification, pyramids and the goods.
