Summer Term 2019 Curriculum Letter

This term our topic focus will be Ancient Egypt. We will be learning about the history of Ancient Egypt and its importance in the wider world.

English this term will be based on the Ancient Egyptians. The children will be writing a series of non-fiction texts such as newspaper reports, biographies, instructions and reports. We will also continue with daily grammar lessons and to learn spellings weekly. In Maths we will be learning formal methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and applying these skills to problem solving

Maths and English homework will still be set on alternate weeks. There will be a continued focus on learning times tables and the associated division facts this term. The children will be given a times table to learn and I will test them on Fridays. The children are also expected to read to an adult for at least 15 minutes a night. Please ensure that you listen to your child read aloud even if they are in Year 5 or 6! It is important to check their fluency and understanding.

PE this term will be country dancing, Tag Rugby and Athletics which will take place on Monday and Friday, kit should be in school all week.

The children will also be working towards a summer performance of 'The Lion King' which will take place in the last week of term.
