As Scientists we will : (Y3-4) Investigate electrical circuits, learn about electrical appliances and test conductors. **(Y6)** draw circuits, plan an investigation and consider renewable energy.

Explore Human Biology and how we develop throughout our lives.

As Linguists we will:

Learn French numbers up to 50 and study French words related to Christmas.

As Citizens we will: (PSHE/Mind Up)

We will cover these topics: What helps me choose?, Strengths and challenges and Out & About.

As Geographers/Historians we will:

Examine the importance and role of Bees in the environment and what we can do to preserve them.

Study Ancient Greece: their early history, their achievements, Alexander The Great, Phillip the Second and their legacy.

As Mathematicians we will: Learn the age appropriate curriculum from the White Rose materials, this means 3 levels of lessons (Y3,Y4 and Y6).

Year 3,4 and 6 will Start with *Place Value and journey* through addition and subtraction; multiplication and division. Y4 will be measuring area and year 6 will learn about fractions.

We also have a login for Times Tables Rock Stars to help children learn their tables, this should be done at home as well as at school.

Look at monochromatic drawing.

In RE we will:

Our Grammar learning targets include: adverbial phrases, prepositions and expanded nouns as well as effective page layouts.
