Swallow Class are learning about hospitals, and it would be great if a real life nurse or doctor could come in and speak to us. If anyone knows anyone who would be happy to do this could you let me know please.

## News from Swallow Class

Our first week back has been great! The reception children have been fantastic at their learning, and it's been lovely seeing the whole class develop their friendships. Y2 have been exploring the book 'Traction Man' in English - (we've been looking at what makes a sentence, and learning what a verb is, and looking at past and present verbs), place value to 100 in Math's, and recapping phase 5 in spellings. Reception have been talking about their special toys, and having conversations with them! Reception have been learning the sounds s, a, t, p in phonics - next week we start blending these to make words. We've been writing numbers in Math's and also started a programme called 'mastering number' which is a 5 minute practice everyday of the basic skills, how numbers look, and how they fit together. This helps children to develop basic number sense which is a firm foundation to a better understanding of number as they move through the school.

We have enjoyed starting our new topics - it's based around superheroes, but we have started with learning and naming body parts for science, and talking about hospitals which have real life superheroes in them. We've looked at the difference between hospitals and doctors and nurses in the past and present.
