As Scientists we will:

Learning about what plants need to thrive and grow. Then we will examine forces: (Y3-4) will look at magnetism while (y5/6) will examine gravity, friction and resistance

So Biology and Physics this term.

As Linguists we will:

Learn French vocabulary and sentences related to the weather and recapping on year 3 and 4 units

As Citizens we will: (PSHE/Mind Up)

Learn about how to keep safe and manage risks to our selves and to our health.

As Geographers/Historians we will:

Explore a theme of 'Crime and Punishment' through lots of different periods in History.

In Geography we will explore different aspects of rivers, including field trips to measure and examine them in more detail.

As Mathematicians we will:

Learn the age appropriate curriculum from the White Rose materials. Year 3,4 and 5 will cover decimals, money shape and fractions.

Year 6 will study shapes including circles and angle measurement as well as recapping and preparing for their tests

We will have a particular focus on learning times tables and the children can use their TTRS logins at home.

Crime and Punishment

As Artists/Designers we will:

Examine how models can be made to move using cogs, levers and other devices.

We will also make coloured sculptures based on food, using clay.

In RE we will:

Study the units 'What matters most to Humanists and to Christians?' As well as 'What can be done to reduce racism? Can religion help?'

In Computing we will:

Explore what the internet is made up of and how to use it as well as how to stay safe whilst accessing it.

As Readers and Writers we will:

The fluency project had a massive impact on the childrens' reading ages so we will build this approach into all our guided reading.

Texts that we will study in English include: Beowulf, Chitty Chitty Bang Bang, Cars, Cogs and Carousels and I am Cat.

Our Grammar learning targets include: verb tenses, expanding noun phrases, making word choices for precise meaning and practising different types of punctuation.

As Athletes we will:

Develop our fundamental skills by taking part in a wide range of athletic activities. The Achieve for All teachers will focus on running and jumping and cricket whilst Mr Middleton will teach throwing and rounders.

As Musicians we will:

Follow the Sing Up scheme to sing protest songs and learn how to play the Melodica. We have borrowed a class set of Melodicas from the music service so we all have one!
