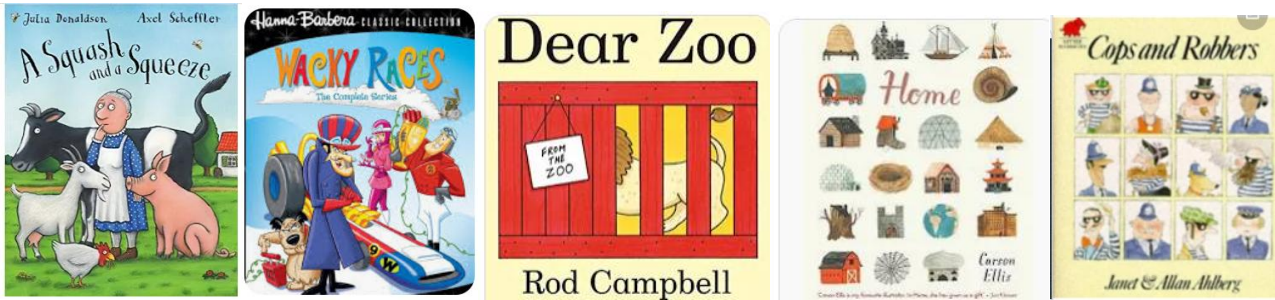


Drawing club books



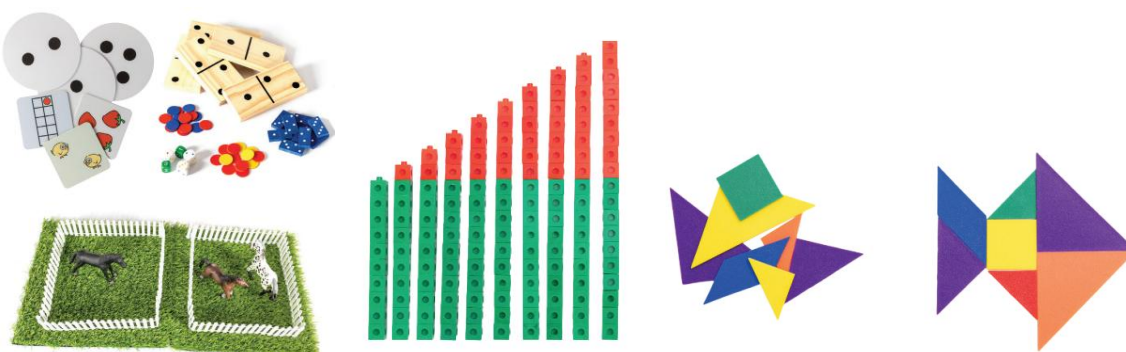

Gross Motor Skills

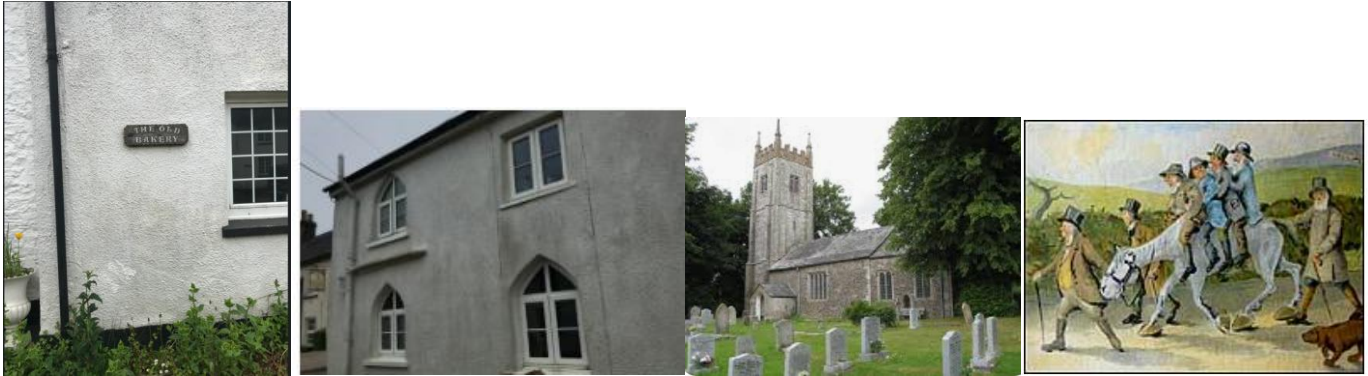
- Negotiate space and obstacles safely, with consideration for themselves and others.

## Understanding the World – We Live in Spreyton

Vocabulary – School, Church, Shop, Park, Village, Fields, Farms, Maps, North, South, East, West, Directions, left, right,

Key Questions: What used to be in Spreyton? What was our school like in the past? Who was Tom Copley? What signs of Spring can I see in Spreyton? What features of the park can I see? How can I find my way to the park? Where are the green spaces in our school?



Key skills: identifying features on a map, following a map, looking for clues from the past, identifying similarities and differences with the past and present.

## Expressive Arts and Design – Wheels and Axles

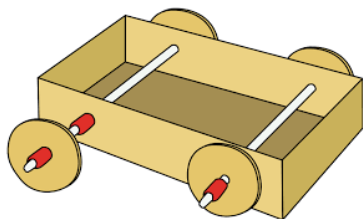
Vocabulary – Wheel, Axle, Vehicle, Moving, Push, Pull, Model

Key Skills: Identify how a toy or vehicle roll forwards.
