As Scientists we will : (Y3-4)

Investigate States of matter and how they can change/ behave under different conditions.

(Y5) Explore the different properties of materials, such as: magnetism and thermal insulation. Explore Human Biology and how our circulation and organs work.

As Linguists we will:

Learn French numbers up to 50 and study French words related to names and greetings.

As Citizens we will: (PSHE/Mind Up)

We will cover these topics: Keeping safe and managing risk as well as Identity, equality and society.

As Geographers/Historians we will:

Study the period when The Romans invaded Britain and the effect it had on the country.

Look at land use including how and why people settle where they do.

Look at the human and physical geography of Europe and especially Italy.

As Mathematicians we will: Learn the age appropriate curriculum from the White Rose materials, this means 3 levels of lessons (Y3,Y4 and Y5).

Year 3,4 and 6 will Start with *Place Value and journey* through addition and subtraction; multiplication and division. Y4 will be measuring area and year 5 will learn about fractions.

We also have a login for Times Tables Rock Stars to help children learn their tables, this can be accessed at home as well as at school.

Romans in Britain

Our Trip will be to Ramm and Roman Exeter to handle artefacts and see what is left from the Roman times.

As Artists/Designers we will:

Look at chromatic drawing as well as looking at the reasons people make art.

In RE we will:

Study the unit 'What would Jesus do?' and 'What it means to be a good Hindu?'

In Computing we will:

Focus on the programming element of the curriculum using the Scratch app to make games and quizzes.

As Readers and Writers we will:

Practise reading aloud individually as well as in groups. We will continue using the format learnt during the Fluency Project.

Texts that we will study in English include: Escape from Pompeii, Cracking Contraptions and Where My Wellies Take Me.

Our Grammar learning targets include: adverbial phrases, conjunctions, advanced punctuation and effective page layouts.

As Athletes we will:

Develop our coordination and ball awareness skills by taking part in a range of athletic activities. The Achieve for All teachers will teach Tennis and Dance whilst Mr Middleton will teach Pickleball and Hockey.

As Musicians we will:

Follow the Sing Up scheme to learn how to play notes on the ukulele, as well as singing and rehearsing the handbells for Christmas. We also have a set of Samba drums to play!
