# Spreyton Primary Curriculum Web (Reception) - Autumn Term 2025



### Expressive Arts and Design:

Children will have daily access to mark making, painting and drawing in different media. We will be focussing on wax rubbings to make a collage.

### In Maths we will be learning:

We'll start off with sorting and matching activities, and then move on to looking in depth at numbers 1,2,3 – subitising, composition, one more and one less. We also focus on deepening understanding of number, and basic concepts such as cardinality, one to one correspondence, and that numbers need to be said in a certain order.



### In Physical Development we will:

To develop technique and body shape through different stages of vertical and horizontal jumping.

To develop stability and balance when using lunge techniques.

### Understanding the world:

As part of our Happy Healthy Me topic we will be starting off by thinking about what makes us unique, our likes and dislikes and what colour our hair and eyes are. Then we'll move into growing, how we've changed since we were babies and that one day we will be adults! We will talk about our families and who are our nuclear and extended family, and then move onto healthy eating, hygiene and exercise.

We will also be looking at some old devices like typewriters, Walkman, and dial up telephones to see how technology has changed.

We will be learning about the routines and expectations of swallow class, lining up, asking to go to the toilet, sharing with friends, playing under the shelter, taking turns, and being kind. So many vital social skills are taught through interaction with friends and with adults.
