As Scientists we will :

All study the unit: 'Animals including Humans' where we will study the workings of the human body, especially the circulatory system and how the heart, lungs and blood work together.

As Linguists we will:

Learn French words and sentences relating to food and eating (including some work on The Very Hungry Caterpillar.

As Citizens we will: (PSHE/Mind Up) We will cover the topic: 'Dealing with Feelings' and a topic on how to stay healthy with regard to the different influences surrounding harmful substances.

As Geographers we will:

Compare our region to areas in Italy and look at how earthquakes and volcanoes function.

As Mathematicians we will: Learn the age appropriate curriculum from the White Rose materials, this means 3 levels of lessons (Y3, Y4 and Y5).

Year 3, 4 and 5 will all start with multiplication and division, moving onto fractions and measuring perimeter and area. Each year group will also study a different measurement topic.

We also have a login for Times Tables Rock Stars to help children learn their tables, this can be accessed at home as well as at school.

As Artists/Designers we will:

Look at non-chromatic art and how design and colour can be used to support a cause or demonstrate a particular point of view.

In RE we will:

Study the unit: 'Creation and science: conflicting or complimentary?'

In Computing we will:

Focus on digital content creation and editing. Year 3-4 will explore editing images while year 5 will work with sound.

As Readers and Writers we will:

Practise reading aloud individually as well as in groups. We will continue using the 'Comprehension Crushers' from Grammarsaurus.

Texts that we will study in English include: 'An Anthology of Intriguing Animals' and 'Once Upon a Tune'. Our Grammar learning targets will mostly focus on writing effective sentences and how to adapt writing for different uses, with a focus on accuracy and flow,

As Athletes we will:

Develop our coordination, strength and ball awareness skills by taking part in a range of athletic activities. The Achieve for All teachers will teach Gymnastics and Tag Rugby whilst Mr Middleton will teach Football and Netball.

As Musicians we will:

Prepare for the Four Elements concert given by the BSO. We will also explore percussion, both tuned (tongue drums) and untuned.
