Swallow Class (Y1/2) – Summer Term 2026



Topic: Summer 1: Minibeasts! Summer 2: Weather and Plants

In Science we will learn:

Living things and their habitats: We will be learning about things that are alive, dead, or never been alive, looking at global habitats and micro habitats closer to home, specifically looking at the compost bin, and what conditions woodlice prefer. We'll look at food chains too.

Plants: We will look at wild plants, garden plants and trees, classifying deciduous and evergreen trees. We will keep a plant diary and observe how it grows, and learn the main parts of a plant, and classify plants based on which part we eat.

In Maths we will be learning:

Y1: will be completing our unit on multiplication and division (counting in 2s, 5s, 10s, equal groups, but not introduced to times tables and the multiply and divide sign until y2)

Y2: We will be working on fractions, money and problem solving.

In PE we will:

Children will re-cap developing techniques and body shape through different stages of vertical and horizontal jumping. They will move onto developing stability and balance when using lunge technique.

In PHSE we will be learning: Drugs, alcohol and tobacco.

- . Where medicines come from.
- . Keeping safe around medicines.

In DT we will be learning about:

How can we make a toy from recycled materials that is fun and safe to play with.

In RE we will be learning:

'What is the good news that Christians believe Jesus brings?'- Children will take time to consider whether Jesus' good news is only good news for Christians or whether there are things from different worldviews to consider.

In Computing we will be learning:

Data and information-pictograms-Children will be introduced to labelling, grouping and searching.

Creating media-digital music-Children will make patterns and use those patterns to make music with both percussion instruments and digital tools.

In Geography we will be learning:

About weather and climate. We will be looking at different climate zones around the world, and about weather forecast and the symbols used for this. We will use instruments for collecting weather data and analyse the data we have collected,

In English we will be using these books :



Y2: To use punctuation correctly, to use commas to write lists, expanded noun phrases, subordination. Develop stamina in writing, proof read to check for punctuation, grammar and spelling.

Y1: To understand what a sentence is, punctuate it correctly and join clauses with 'and'. Use capital letters for names, places and days of the week. Use question marks and exclamation marks correctly.

In Music we will be:

Listen to music and create a minibeast dance. Sing clearly, smoothly and together in time. Play an accompaniment on a percussion instrument. Compose minibeast sound effects on instruments.
