

Dear Parents

During the Summer Term the children in Hare Class will be learning about The Romans. Please have a look at the termly topic outline on the back of this sheet.

The first half term focus will be on History skills such as sequencing events in chronological order, finding out why the Romans came to Britain and the legacy they left behind. This will be supported by our English, Art and Music topics.

The second half term will focus on Geography skills and we will be studying how and why volcanoes and earthquakes occur and the human impact of these.

We also have some exciting trips and activities for the Summer Term including; going to Exeter Museum and having a guided Roman tour, the class residential, sports day and the school production, which this year will be Matilda.

As usual, children are expected to read every night for 20-30 minutes, practise their spellings and times tables, which are tested on a Wednesday and Friday, respectively.
