Census Day

Thursday 18th January is School Census Day and we would like to encourage all of our children to have a school dinner on this day.

The School Census is used to determine our allocation of funds from Devon County Council and school dinner uptake is a major indicator for these funds. If we can encourage as many of our pupils as possible to have a school dinner next Thursday this will impact our schools financial position and ultimately benefit our pupils. Please see above for details of the special menu for that day.

Our school funding is also greatly influenced by the number of pupils eligible for Free School Meals. This is a separate funding pot from the Universal Infant Free Meals that pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive. Free School Meals (FSM) generate Pupil Premium income for our school, again a valuable additional fund which benefits the whole school. Families eligible for FSM can apply on-line (https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals). Please take time to check to see if you may be eligible and please apply for FSM if you believe you may be entitled as it really does benefit our school.
